TANDO JAM (Press Release): Pre- entry Test for the academic year 2017-2018 of Sindh agriculture university Tandojam was held on Sunday, 31st December 2017 at Public School Hyderabad. Total (2773) candidates appeared in the entry test including 2504 boys and 269 female candidates. The test was also conducted for admissions of Shaheed Zulfiqar Ali Bhutto Agricultural College Dokri (SZABAC), Khairpur College of Agricultural Engineering and Technology (KCAT) and the new Umerkot campus.

According to public relation officer of SAU Tandojam, Ali Asghar Bhatti, the University has made a district-wise allocation of a total 1,500 seats, offering for admission to its five faculties, two institutes and colleges situated at Dokri, Umerkot and Khairpur Mirs. Total 2773 candidates appeared including 2504 male Candidates and 269 female candidates.

The five faculties of SAU include Agricultural Engineering, Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Sciences, Agricultural Social Science, Crop Production and Crop Protection. While the two institutes are Information Technology Center and Institute of Food Sciences and Technology. The two affiliated colleges, Shaheed Zulfiqar Ali Bhutto Agricultural College Dokri, Khairpur College of Agricultural Engineering and Technology. The new Umerkot Campus is going to start its first Session from this year.

Strict security arrangements were made on the occasion including walk through gates. Large numbers of Police and Rangers Personnel was deployed on the occasion of Pre-entry test. Besides that, the University also deployed its Security Staff.

The Vice Chancellor of SAU, Prof. Dr. Mujeeb-ud-din Sahrai visited the place of Entry Test. Dr. Sahrai while talking to media said that Entry Test has been conducted in peaceful atmosphere and different facilities are provided to the candidates appearing in the test. He further said the ranking of Agriculture University Tandojam is improving day by day and we are trying our best to provide more facilities to students so that they would be able to meet future challenges. University is on the path of fast development and we believe it provide quality education and technical expertise to its students. He further said that the number of female students is increasing at the university and this is a very good sign leading to gender balance in education and society.
