Research Fellows Required

The Australian Government funded Project through Australian Centre for International Agriculture Research (ACIAR) to the department of Agronomy, SAU Tandojam, title of the project: **“Increasing productivity and profitability of pulse production in cereal based cropping system in Pakistan”** requires three “Research Fellows” for its 65 different field experiments at different locations of district Larkana. All the interested students of **M.Sc. (Agri.) Hons. in Agronomy batches 2K18 and senior batch 2K17** submit their Cvs, attested necessary documents/testimonials **from Matric to last degree and 04 Passport size photographs on or before 26.11.2019** during working hours. The Research fellows will be paid daily allowance @ **Rs. 1,000/=** (Rupees one thousand per day/visit only).

The responsibilities of the research fellows will be as below:

1. Prepare synopsis for Master Research program under this project.
2. Field visits of their personal as well as other field trials of this project, maximum three visits in a week.
3. Collection and analysis of data for all necessary parameters from all field trials.
4. Thesis write-up, to be submitted before or during month of December, 2020.
5. Presentation of seminars at different forums whenever necessary.
6. Submission of monthly reports of all field trials to concerned authority.
7. The fellowship is purely on temporary bases for the period of five months only from 01st December, 2019 to 30th April, 2020. The selected candidates will have no right to claim for regularization of their fellowship. The selected candidates will be paid above given daily allowance for these five months only.
8. An experience certificate for the period of five months of “Research Fellowship” will be issued to the selected candidates after successful completion of the research fellowship.

Procedure for the selection of research fellows:

1. A written test will be conducted in the end of the November, 2019.
2. The candidates, who will qualify the written test, will appear for interview in the end of the month of the November, 2019.
3. The successful / selected candidates will submit an “Affidavit” for agreeing all conditions for this research fellowship. The affidavits will be signed-in by two witnesses.
